Our Traditional Funeral

Our Professional Fees:

£ 1,490.00

Our service charge includes the provision of a 24 hour service by telephone and the use of our Chapels of Rest during office hours without charge. As a company we have traditionally visited our families in their own homes (if they reside locally) to make the funeral arrangements and subsequent visits before and after the funeral. Our aim is for the family to have the same Funeral Director from the initial contact through to the day of the funeral. We will advise in relation to the registration of the death, the funeral service and give advice on the options available to you as a family for the funeral. We will complete the necessary documentation for burial or cremation and liaise with third parties and make payments to them on your behalf. The administration of donations in memory of your loved one are included in the above cost. We will collect the cremated remains if a local crematorium is used and retain according to your wishes without a time limit. As is tradition we will also record the names of mourners who attend for a local funeral service.

Bringing the deceased into our care: (45 running miles)

£ 215.00

If the deceased passed away at a private residence the above charge applies day or night, 7 days a week. If the death occurred in Hospital, we will endeavour to bring the deceased into our care as soon as possible using our own vehicles, once the required paperwork has been completed. The cost includes the dressing of the deceased in their own clothes or the provision of a dressing gown robe.

Embalming:

£ 145.00

Embalming is the temporary preservation of the deceased which also gives a more natural skin tone. Whilst not a legal requirement, there are many benefits that this process can bring and can extend the time available to the family at the Chapel of Rest.

The Hearse: £ 275.00

Our hearse is generally driven by the Funeral Director with whom the funeral arrangements were made. (60 running miles)

There are other vehicles available for the conveyance of the coffin, such as a motorcycle or horse drawn hearse etc. Price on request.

The Limousine: £ 275.00

Our limousines are chauffeur driven and seat seven passengers as a maximum. The Limousine can leave from the residence, or another venue, follow the hearse and return you to a venue after the funeral service. (Within 60 running miles)

Bearers: £195.00

The provision of four bearers for the funeral service, using a wheeled bier at a church service and crematorium or cemetery.

Preparation of the Cremated Remains Plot:

£ 85.00

This includes the opening of the plot and replacing the soil after the interment.

Disbursements:

Disbursements are paid on behalf of our client and include fees charged by the following; churches, cemeteries, crematoria, obituary notices, floral tributes, the printing of order of services, etc. These disbursements will be listed on your estimate of funeral costs and on our final invoice.

Estimate and Invoice:

Burial - with plain sides & lid, brass effect metal handles & nameplate. Cremation with plain sides & lid, wooden handles and nameplate.

The Banana Leaf:

£810.00

Suitable for burial or cremation, handles and nameplate:

The Woollen Coffin:

£810.00

Available in dark limestone, brown or white, suitable for burial or cremation (not accepted in all crematoria), with handles and nameplate.

The Wicker Coffin:

£ 980.00

Suitable for burial or cremation, with woven handles and wooden nameplate.

The Solid Oak Coffin:

£ 1210.00

With plain sides & lid, with brass effect metal handles and nameplate.

The Solid Sapele Coffin:

£ 1365.00

With panelled sides, plain lid, brass effect metal handles and nameplate.

Cremated Remains Casket:

A solid oak cremated remains casket, with a brass effect metal nameplate.

Preparation of the Cremated Remains Plot:

This includes the opening of the plot and replacing the soil after the interment.
